

Wild Bunch

The SASS Wild Bunch Handbook will be followed. You will need a SASS legal rifle .40 caliber or larger, a 12 gauge 1897 shotgun, civilian or military, original or reproduction and a full size 1911 Colt style pistol in .45acp. You will need at least four magazines (six recommended). Pistol magazines may not have bumper pads. Magazines may be 7 or 8 rounds but will always be loaded with only 5 rounds. Consult the handbook for Modern or Traditional Categories, power factor, and other questions.

You will need 50 pistol rounds (lead bullets), 30 rifle rounds (lead bullets) and 15 shotgun rounds (shot size 7 ½ or smaller). You will also need a safe way (holster and magazine carrier) to transport your 1911 to and from the stage but there will be a flat surface on which to stage your pistol and magazines.

You may reload from your person for ejected live rounds from rifle or shotgun, but misses will not be made up. Reloading the 1911 will be from slide lock with a full (5 round) magazine. You may not load a single round in your pistol or perform tactical reloads. In the event of a malfunction, a partially loaded magazine may be removed and replaced with a full (5 round) magazine and the shooting sequence continued.

Your 1911 can be carried in a holster, slide forward, chamber empty with no magazine. A magazine may be inserted in your 1911 at the loading bench, and at the conclusion of each stage the RO will verify your 1911 safe by watching you remove the empty magazine (if inserted), showing the chamber empty, lowering the slide, pointing the pistol safely down range and pulling the trigger. No further inspection of the 1911 is required. The rifle and shotgun will be checked unloaded at the unloading table.
